Dear families,

I hope you're well.

In an announcement this week, the Prime Minister said that it will not be possible to reopen schools immediately after the February half-term. This means that, after half-term, we will continue to offer remote learning for the majority of our pupils, so that they will continue their education at home. We will remain open for the children of key workers and vulnerable children only.

The government has said that schools could potentially start to welcome more children back from 8th March, at the earliest. Over the last few days this has led to some speculation. Once we know more regarding this, we will update you.

Can I also thank you for all that you are doing to support us and your children at this moment in time. I appreciate how difficult it can be. The most important thing, as I said to Year 10 in assembly this morning, is to continue accessing the remote learning over the next two weeks and then use half term wisely to recover.
